Recycling All You Can and Want to do More? Sign Up for the Anoka County Organics Drop-off Program!

Recycle food scraps, paper products, coffee grounds and more at Anoka County yard waste sites for FREE. When you participate in the organics recycling program, your food scraps and non-recyclable paper products will be recycled into compost at a commercial compost facility. Compost is a valuable resource that improves soil, reduces erosion and decreases the need for fertilizers. Available to Anoka County residents only.

How do I sign up?

In Anoka County there are several options, the Anoka County Organics Recycling Program or City and Township Organics Recycling Programs.

To get started with the County Drop-off Program go to AnokaCountyMN.gov/organics

- Please sign up using our online form. (Contact information is gathered so that we can notify you of updates or changes to the organics drop-off program.)
- Pick up a free starter kit at the compost sites during hours of operation.
- Collect organic waste in a compostable bag and tie off the bag.
- Come to the compost site and place organics in the container designated for organics recycling.
- Grab more BPI certified bags from the dispensers on your way out.

Yes

Mixed paper

- Mail, office & school papers
- Magazines & catalogs
- Newspapers & inserts
- Paper towel & toilet paper cores
- Phone books

Boxes

- Cardboard
- Cereal, cracker & pasta boxes
- Shoe, gift & electronics boxes
- Toiletry boxes
- Tissue boxes

No

- Food & grease soiled boxes
- Egg cartons
- Freezer boxes
- Paper towels, napkins, paper plates & cups
- Gift wrap & tissue
- Envelopes with bubble-wrap



Glass

Yes

- Beverage & food bottles & jars

No

- Drinking glasses, mugs, dishes, cook ware, pottery & vases
- Window & mirror glass
- Nail polish or hobby paint containers
- Light bulbs



Metal

Yes

- Beverage cans
- Food cans
- Aluminum foil, trays & pie tins

No

- Paint cans
- Aerosol cans
- Paint thinner or automotive fluid containers
- Scrap metal, such as cookware, nails & hangers



Cartons

Yes

- Milk cartons
- Juice cartons
- Juice boxes (straws removed)
- Soup, broth & wine cartons

- Ice cream cartons
- Egg cartons
- Plastic straws
- Foil drink pouches
- Take-out cartons

Plastic

Yes

Bottles & jugs Plastic #1, 2 & 5

- Water, soda & juice bottles
- Milk & juice jugs
- Ketchup & salad dressing bottles
- Shampoo, soap & lotion bottles
- Laundry containers

Cups, tubs & containers Plastic #1, 2 & 5

- Yogurt, pudding & fruit cups
- Clear plastic cups & produce containers
- Margarine, cottage cheese, cream cheese, other tubs & lids

No

Plastic #3, 4, 6 & 7

- Plastic bags
- Styrofoam® #6
- Automotive fluid & pesticide containers
- Black containers
- Utensils & straws

Remember...

No batteries, plastic bags, extension cords, string lights or shredded paper in your curbside recycling cart. Bring these items to a drop-off, go to AnokaCountyMN.gov/recyclingdirectory for locations.

Food and Beverage Containers

- Empty all containers and rinse out food debris.
- Replace plastic caps and lids on plastic containers.
- Remove metal and plastic lids from glass containers.
- Toss large metal lids in loose and pinch smaller metal lids within food cans.

Paper

- Discard or compost any paper with food, grease, dirt or mold.
- Remove plastic bags, plastic film and any promotional items from newspaper and unwanted mail.
- Flatten and remove any packaging or excessive tape from cardboard boxes.

Recycling Events at Recycle Technologies in Blaine

Where: Recycle Technologies (formerly Green Lights Recycling)
1525 99th Lane NE, Blaine (Enter site from 99th Lane NE)

Time: 8 a.m. – 12 p.m.

Materials Accepted for FREE:

- Bicycles (children's and adult)
- Miscellaneous electronic items (tablets, servers, cables, string lights, laptops, and cell phones)
- Scrap metal (must be clean with all non-metal materials removed)
- Motor vehicle batteries or any sealed lead-acid battery
- Paper for shredding (two box maximum, no 3-ring binders or newspaper)



Materials Accepted for a \$FEE\$:

- Appliances – small and large (\$12 - \$30 each)
- Batteries – all types of small household batteries (\$1.75 - \$6.75/lb)
- Electronics – all types (\$6 - \$85 each)
- Fire extinguishers (dry chemical) - \$30 each
- Fluorescent lamps (\$0.50 - \$0.95 each, HID \$2.50 each)
- Fluorescent light fixtures with ballasts - \$25 each
- Hard drive shredding - \$5 each
- Mattresses and box springs (\$20 - \$25 each)
- Propane tanks (must be empty) (\$6 - \$20 each)
- Smoke detectors (must contain 1.0 microcurie or less) - \$20 each
- Tires - car and truck with or without rim (\$7 - \$9 each)

Prices have a range since they vary by the size and type of material.

All materials accepted at the Recycle Technologies Event (with exception of hard drive shredding) plus more!

- Automotive fluids/filters – used motor oil, used oil filters and antifreeze
- Cardboard (flatten, remove packaging materials and excessive tape)
- Donate usable clothing, linens, household goods, small pieces of furniture, books and more to the Salvation Army. All items should be boxed or bagged for easy transport.
- Trash – no hazardous materials. Go to AnokaCountyMN.gov/HHW for information about the Anoka County Household Hazardous Waste Facility in Blaine.
