

ROAD CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

To: Residents of Hamline Avenue and Flowerfield Road.

Subject: Curbing Installation and Parking Restrictions
Date: August 23, 2017

The curbing subcontractor is planning to begin concrete curbing on Hamline Avenue and Flowerfield Road on Thursday, August 24th. The concrete driveways for Hamline Avenue and Flowerfield Road will be on Friday, August 25th. Access to your driveway will be restricted for a minimum of 5 to 7 days following the installation to allow the concrete to cure. If you will need to use your vehicle during that time, please remove the vehicle from your driveway no later than 7:00 a.m. on Thursday August 24th. There will be no parking allowed on the street on August 24th or 25th during the work day. You will be able to park on adjacent streets that allow parking. After the curb and driveway are installed, you will be able to park on the street adjacent to your driveway. Be very careful not to hit the newly poured curb. As a safety precaution, please avoid parking across from another parked car. Cars parked directly across from one another may be too narrow for emergency vehicles.
