They will be collecting non-perishable food donations benefiting the local food shelf. Non-perishable food items can be brought to City Hall anytime





With all the holiday cooking going on this time of year please check to make sure your smoke detectors are in working order. Cooking leads to over 70% of fire injuries this time of the year. Remember to change the batteries in your smoke detector 2 times a year and have one in every bedroom, in the hall outside each bedroom and on each level of your home.
