Production Highlights

NMTV News Highlights

Each week Danika Peterson and Ben Hayle create a news program that highlights events, people, issues, and information important to citizens of the our Member Cities. Some October highlights include the battle over Unity Hospital, Lino Lakes' Beyond the Yellow Ribbon program, the Lexington write in campaign, federal grants providing new court options for Anoka County, and the line-painters at Blaine's Bengal Stadium. In addition to daily playbacks of North Metro TV News on the



cable systems, there are over 324 local stories archived for viewers on the NMTV YouTube page. The page can be accessed through the northmetroty.com website.

Debates!

October was another busy month for election related programming. Ben and Danika taped ten more candidate debates including candidates for Blaine, Spring Lake Park, Centerville, Anoka County and a state Senate seat. T.J. Tronson covered the League of Women Voter's debate at Centerville City Hall, and also produced an informational video regarding the Blaine Community Center referendum. The news team put together news clips regarding the Blaine referendum, the Unity Hospital board



issues and also the Lexington write-in campaign. The City of Columbia Heights also hired NMTV to record their candidate debates.

DaVinci Academy Workshops

Instructor, Eric Houston, has completed another series of after-school workshops with the students of the DaVinci Academy. Twelve students were signed up to learn the basics of video production. As their class project, the kids worked together to record new voices and sound effects for a 1930's movie serial. They also each got to record a short movie review. The kids put together three programs which are currently playing on the public access channel. The school has scheduled another on-location session for January 2017.



Expansion of Municipal Services

NMTV staff are working to provide more services to our Member Cities. While staff already schedules programming on the channels, this service has been expanded to include community or City related programs in addition to City meetings. City meetings will also be repeated more frequently on the channels in order to increase the video content on each channel. Steps are also being taken to improve the community bulletin board graphics that appear on the channels between video programming. In order to remove the burden of updating these pages, NMTV staff will create and update data on each City device. Discussions have taken place regarding upgrading the equipment used to create the data pages to a Tightrope Carousel system that would be integrated with NMTV's new master control. The benefit of such an upgrade would be HD quality content, with more flexibility for including short videos and other data sources. The units would be housed at the NMTV facility, which would reduce the distance the signal would have to travel before reaching subscribers homes, improving the signal quality.

HD Upgrade

The HD upgrade of Master Control, Studio B, and Studio A is essentially completed. Staff have been trained and the systems are being tested. Punch lists are being developed as issues come up. It is expected that the system should be completely functional for the election night program. The production truck is slated for delivery either late November or early December. Alpha Video will then install the new equipment in the truck. It's possible that it could be done this year, but it may carry over into January.



ORDINANCE NO. 16-04

AN ORDINANCE IMPLEMENTING AN ELECTRIC SERVICE FRANCHISE FEE ON NORTHERN STATES POWER COMPANY, A MINNESOTA CORPORATION, ITS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS, FOR PROVIDING ELECTRIC SERVICE WITHIN THE CITY OF LEXINGTON

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LEXINGTON DOES ORDAIN:

SECTION 1. The City of Lexington Municipal Code is hereby amended to include reference to the following Special Ordinance.

- **Subd. 1.** <u>Purpose</u>. The Lexington City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to impose a franchise fee on those public utility companies that provide electric services within the City of Lexington.
 - (a) Pursuant to City Ordinance No. 11-05, a Franchise Agreement between the City of Lexington and Northern States Power Company, a Minnesota corporation, its successors and assigns, the City has the right to impose a franchise fee on Northern States Power Company, a Minnesota corporation, its successors and assigns, in an amount and fee design as set forth in Section 9.1 of the Northern States Power Company Franchise and in the fee schedule attached hereto as Schedule A.
- **Subd. 2.** <u>Franchise Fee Statement</u>. A franchise fee is hereby imposed on Northern States Power Company, a Minnesota Corporation, its successors and assigns, under its electric franchise in accordance with the schedule attached here to and made a part of this Ordinance, commencing with the NSPM February 2017 billing month.

This fee is an account-based fee on each premise and not a meter-based fee. In the event that an entity covered by this ordinance has more than one meter at a single premise, but only one account, only one fee shall be assessed to that account. If a premise has two or more meters being billed at different rates, the Company may have an account for each rate classification, which will result in more than one franchise fee assessment for electric service to that premise. If the Company combines the rate classifications into a single account, the franchise fee assessed to the account will be the largest franchise fee applicable to a single rate classification for energy delivered to that premise. In the event any entities covered by this ordinance have more than one premise, each premise (address) shall be subject to the appropriate fee. In the event a question arises as to the proper fee amount for any premise, the Company's manner of billing for energy used at all similar premises in the city will control.

- **Subd. 3.** Payment. The said franchise fee shall be payable to the City in accordance with the terms set forth in Section 9 of the Franchise.
- **Subd. 4.** <u>Surcharge</u>. The City recognizes that the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission may allow Company to add a surcharge to customer rates of city residents to reimburse Company for the cost of the fee.

Subd. 5. Enforcement. Any dispute, including enforcement of a default regarding this ordinance will be resolved in accordance with Section 2.5 of the Franchise Agreement.

Subd. 6. Effective Date of Franchise Fee. The effective date of this Ordinance shall be after its publication and ninety (90) days after the sending of written notice enclosing a copy of this adopted Ordinance to NSPM by certified mail. Collection of the fee shall commence as provided above.

ORDINANCE NO. 16-05 CITY OF LEXINGTON COUNTY OF ANOKA STATE OF MINNESOTA

AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING THE ELECTRIC FRANCHISE FEE ON CONEXUS ENERGY FOR PROVIDING ELECTRIC SERVICE WITHIN THE CITY OF LEXINGTON. THE CITY OF LEXINGTON ORDAINS:

SECTION 1. The City of Lexington Code of Ordnances is hereby amended as follows:

Subdivision 1. Purpose. The Lexington City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to impose a franchise fee on those public utility companies that provide natural gas and electric services within the City of Lexington.

- (a) Pursuant to City Ordinance No. 12-07, a Franchise Agreement between the City and Conexus Energy, the City has the right to impose a franchise fee on Conexus Energy in amount and fee design as authorized in Section 9.1 of the Conexus Energy Franchise.
- (b) Pursuant to City Ordinance No. 13-01, the City exercised its right to impose a franchise fee on Conexus Energy. This includes the right to modify the fee amount with the consent of Conexus Energy as to amount and notice period, to which Conexus Energy has consented.
- Subd. 2. Franchise Fee Statement. Pursuant to Ordinance No. 13-01, the franchise fee imposed on Conexus Energy under its Electric Franchise is hereby amended. The amended fee schedule is attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance, commencing with the Conexus Energy's February 2017 billing month.
- Subd. 3. Effective Date of Franchise Fee. Notwithstanding the effective date of this ordinance and notwithstanding any contrary provisions in the Franchise, the effective date of the fee collected under Subdivision 2 of this ordinance is the later of ten (10) days after the publication or after the sending of written notice enclosing a copy of this adopted ordinance upon Conexus Energy by certified mail.

ORDINANCE NO. 16-06

AN ORDINANCE IMPLEMENTING A GAS ENERGY FRANCHISE FEE ON CENTERPOINT ENERGY MINNESOTA GAS ("CENTERPOINT ENERGY") FOR PROVIDING GAS ENERGY SERVICE WITHIN THE CITY OF LEXINTON, MINNESOTA

THE CITY OF LEXINGTON DOES ORDAIN:

Gas Franchise Fee

- (a) *Definitions*. For the purposes of this Ordinance, the following terms shall have the following meanings:
- (1) City. The City of Lexington, County of Anoka, State of Minnesota.
- (2) Company. CenterPoint Energy Minnesota Gas ("CenterPoint Energy"), its successors and assigns.
- (3) Franchise Agreement. The franchise agreement between the City and Company pursuant to an Ordinance adopted by the City on December 3, 2009.
- (4) Notice. "Notice" means a writing served by any party or parties on any other party or parties. Notice to Company shall be mailed to CenterPoint Energy, Minnesota Division Vice President, 505 Nicollet mall, Minneapolis, MN 55402. Notice to City shall be mailed to the City Clerk at 1880 Main Street, Lexington, Minnesota 55038.
- (b) *Purpose*. The Lexington City Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to impose a franchise fee on those public utility companies that provide natural gas and electric services within the City. Pursuant to the Franchise Agreement the City has the right to impose a franchise fee on Company.
- (c) Franchise Fee Statement and Schedule. A franchise fee is hereby imposed on Company commencing with the May 2016 billing month, and in accordance with the following fee schedule:

Amount per Account per Month (\$)

Residential	\$ 4.00 per month
Firm A	\$ 6.50 per month
Firm B	\$ 40.00 per month
Firm C	\$ 170.00 per month
Small Volume, Dual Fuel A ("SVDF A")	\$ 0.00 per month
Small Volume, Dual Fuel B ("SVDF B")	\$ 0.00 per month
Large Volume, Dual Fuel ("LVDF")	\$ 0.00 per month

- (d) Account Fee. This fee is an account based fee and not a meter-based fee. In the event that an entity covered by this ordinance has more than one meter, but only one account, only one fee shall be assessed to that account. In the event any entities covered by this ordinance have more than one account, each account shall be subject to the appropriate fee. In the event a question arises as to the proper fee amount for any account, the highest possible fee amount shall apply.
- (e) *Payment*. Franchise fees are to be collected by the Company, consistent with the Minnesota Public Utility Commission's March 23, 2011 Order establishing franchise fee filing requirements in Docket No. E,G999/CI-09-970, and submitted to the City as follows:

January – March collections due by April 30. April – June collections due by July 31. July – September collections due by October 31. October – December collections due by January 31.

- (f) Record Support for Payment. The Company shall make each payment when due and, if requested by the City, shall provide a statement summarizing how the franchise fee payment was determined, including information showing any adjustments to the total made to account for any non-collectible accounts, refunds or error corrections. The Company shall permit the City, and its representatives, access to the Company's records for the purpose of verifying such statements.
- (g) Payment Adjustments. Payment to the City will be adjusted where the Company is unable to collect the franchise fee. This includes non-collectible accounts
- (h) *Surcharge*. The City recognizes that the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission may allow the Company to add a surcharge to customer rates of city residents to reimburse the Company for the cost of the fee, consistent with the Minnesota Public Utility Commission's March 23, 2011 Order establishing franchise fee filing requirements in Docket No. E,G999/CI-09-970.
- (i) Dispute Resolution. If either party asserts that the other party is in default in the performance of any obligation hereunder, the complaining party shall notify the other party of the default and the desired remedy. The notification shall be written. Representatives of the parties must promptly meet and attempt in good faith to negotiate a resolution of the dispute. If the dispute is not resolved within 30 days of the written notice, the parties may jointly select a mediator to facilitate further discussion. The parties will equally share the fees and expenses of this mediator. If a mediator is not used or if the parties are unable to resolve the dispute within 30 days after first meeting with the

Franchise Fee Ordinance Lexington - CenterPoint version 11/09/2016 selected mediator, either party may commence an action in District Court to interpret and enforce this ordinance or for such other relief permitted by law.

- (j) Effective Date of Franchise Fee. The effective date of this Ordinance shall be after its publication and ninety (90) days or more after sending written notice enclosing a copy of this adopted Ordinance to Company by certified mail or personal service. Collection of the fee shall commence as provided above.
- (k) Relation to Franchise Agreement. This ordinance is enacted in compliance with the Franchise Agreement and shall be interpreted as such.
- (l) *Periodic Review*. The City Council shall review this ordinance annually in whatever manner the City then determines to be appropriate, including, but not limited to, review by the City Council in either a work session or a regular session. Failure to review this ordinance shall not in any way invalidate or limit it.

Section 2: Effective Date. This ordinance takes effect as provided herein.
