A RESOLUTION REQUESTING ANOKA COUNTY FOR ASSISTANCE WITH SPEEDING ON LOVELL ROAD

WHEREAS, County State Aid Highway 52, also known as Lovell Road, transits the City of Lexington (the "City"). The Highway enters the City with a speed limit of 50 mph and changes to 35 mph as it enters a residential neighborhood. Traffic speeds and car counts have significantly increased over the years as the population in the vicinity has also increased.

WHEREAS, the Residents along Lovell Road are fearful of the increased traffic and speed of traffic on the road. The Residents feel these traffic problems present a significant safety risk.

WHEREAS, the City of Lexington desires to work in partnership with Anoka County to help increase safety along Lovell Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Lexington, Minnesota, asks the following with respect to County State Aid Highway 52:

- 1. The City desires the County to study the traffic problems along Lovell Road;
- 2. The City requests the County to erect automated speed detection signs that display the speed of approaching vehicles;
- 3. The City requests the County to erect additional signage indicating speed changes from 50 mph to 35 mph; and
- 4. The City requests the County employ the use of traffic calming technics and the construction of traffic calming improvements.
